



ALC Remote Reading Program

Due to phenomenal growth, the Australian Literacy Clinic has now rolled out its reading program nationally under the banner of **ALC Remote Reading Program**.

Who is the program for?

ALC Remote Reading Program is for any child struggling with reading. The program is aimed at all children who have difficulties with reading and who are in K-6.

How do you teach my child to read?

ALC Remote Reading Program has been specifically designed by the company's Managing Director and Literacy Specialist. *ALC Remote Reading Program* follows a similar format to our in-house clinic reading program however differs in its content. Specially trained ALC Reading Specialists contact all *ALC Remote Reading Program* students via telephone at preset weekly times. Each student uses our online resources to develop their reading skills with the Reading Specialist.

How long does the telephone lesson take?

ALC Remote Reading Program lasts for 15 minutes and occurs weekly.

What resources do I need?

All *ALC Remote Reading Program* resources are available online. These resources are required for the *ALC Remote Reading Program*. No other resources are needed.

Does a parent/carer need to be present?

It is advisable that a parent/carer is close by. At times our Reading Specialists will give you suggestions as to how you can assist your child with their reading. A parent/carer DOES NOT implement the reading lesson, this is done by the Reading Specialist.

Do I call ALC?

No. ALC Remote Reading Specialists contact all children at predetermined times and phone numbers. The time allocated is your weekly time unless you decide to change.

How do you know my child's reading ability?

ALC implements a reading test at the beginning of the program in order to determine a child's reading ability. This is done over the telephone. ALC also collects relevant educational, behavioural and medical information from the parent/caregiver at time of remote testing. Full written reports follow all testing. Tests are emailed to clients prior to appointment time.

Do you get results?

ABSOLUTELY! *ALC Remote Reading Program* has been running successfully for 12 months and the results for all children have been significant. *ALC Remote Reading Program* has shown the same significant increase in reading ability as the in-house clinic program which has been operating for over 4 years. All children who participate in the *ALC Remote Reading Program* are tested each 10 weeks in order to monitor progress. Children who attend our clinics on average increase 9 months in reading ability per term.

This all sounds brilliant but how much will it cost?

ALC Remote Reading Program is highly affordable.

Initial Remote Assessment: \$120.00 (one time only)

Yearly access fee to online resources: \$99.00

Weekly ALC Remote Reading Program: \$30.00 per week

Ongoing assessments: nil. This is included as part of the weekly program.
